Dear mammography radiologists:

As of October 22, 2018, the Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) is holding rotating strikes in certain areas across Canada. During rotating strikes, Canada Post will continue to accept, process and deliver mail and parcels in all areas that are not affected. Once the 24-hour period expires, Canada Post would return to normal operations in the affected locations. Please check the Canada Post website for locations affected.

The Alberta Breast Cancer Screening Program and the Alberta Society of Radiologists have the following advice regarding Women's Results Letters **to be activated SHOULD A FULL STRIKE OCCUR:**

The ABCSP and the ASR would appreciate your support to ensure continuity of care for our clients. The following process is for a full Canada Post strike that lasts 4-6 weeks; should the strike last longer than this, we will communicate a longer term plan.

- a) If possible, please hand the result letter to the client.
- b) If providing the result letter at the site of service is not possible, please
  - i. inform the client that results will be made available to their listed physician and to contact the physician for that information, and
  - ii. to inform the client that as soon as the strike ends the client should expect to receive the result in her mail.
- c) Once the strike is over, deliver correspondence by regular post.
- d) Continue to provide the notations on the submission forms (it will be interpreted for the strike period as a notation that the correspondence is intended to be delivered).
