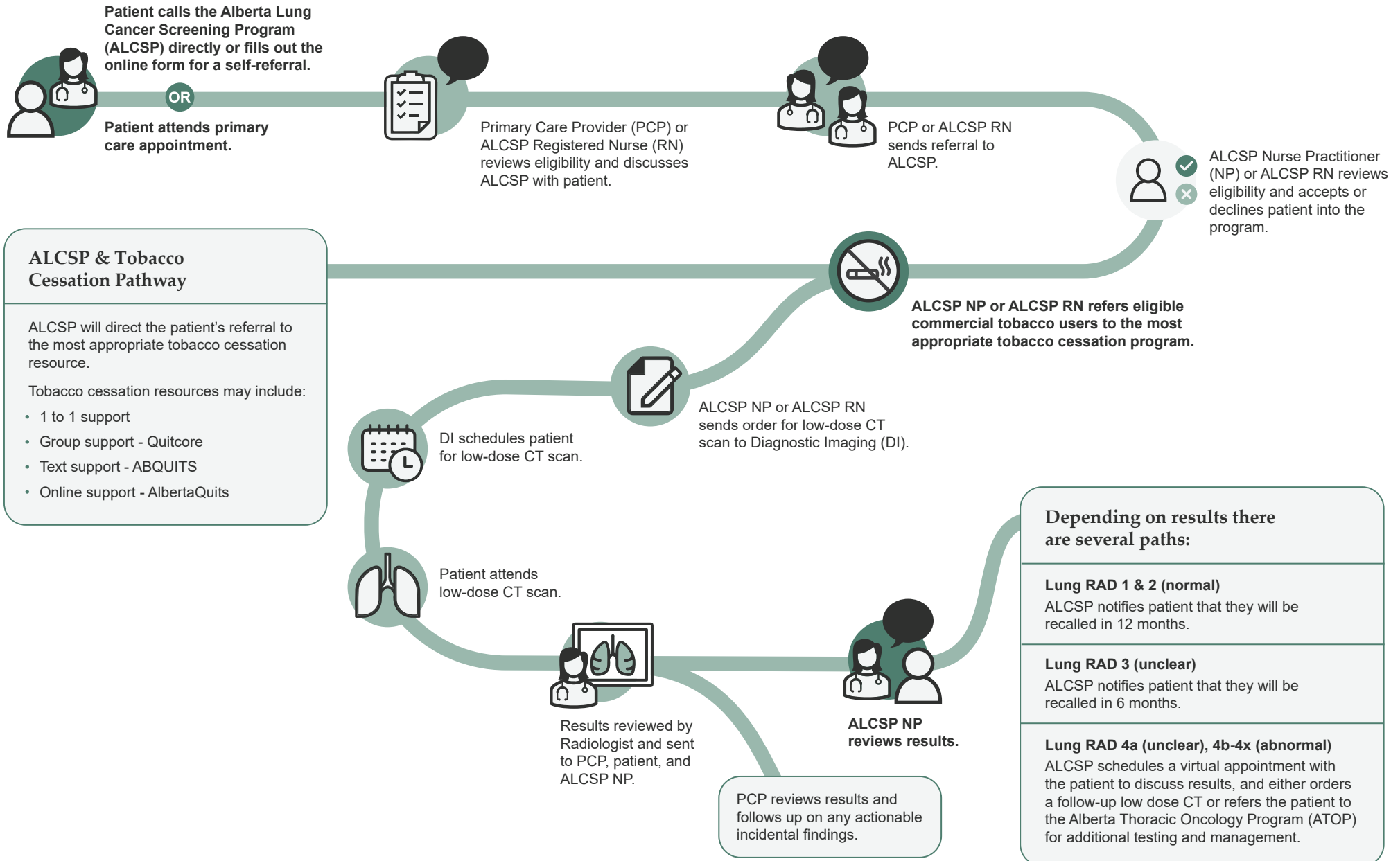


# Patient Pathway

### ALCSP & Tobacco Cessation Pathway

ALCSP will direct the patient's referral to the most appropriate tobacco cessation resource.

Tobacco cessation resources may include:

- 1 to 1 support
- Group support - Quitcore
- Text support - ABQUITS
- Online support - AlbertaQuits

### Depending on results there are several paths:

- Lung RAD 1 & 2 (normal)**  
ALCSP notifies patient that they will be recalled in 12 months.
- Lung RAD 3 (unclear)**  
ALCSP notifies patient that they will be recalled in 6 months.
- Lung RAD 4a (unclear), 4b-4x (abnormal)**  
ALCSP schedules a virtual appointment with the patient to discuss results, and either orders a follow-up low dose CT or refers the patient to the Alberta Thoracic Oncology Program (ATOP) for additional testing and management.
