## No more Reminder Letters from the Alberta Breast Cancer Screening Program (ABCSP)

Now that you're 75, you will no longer receive reminder or mobile announcement letters (MAL) to screen.

### Why won't I receive future letters from the ABCSP?

Breast cancer screening is recommended for women aged 50 to 74 who are at average risk of developing breast cancer. During that time, you may have received reminder letters or MALs from the ABCSP whenever our records showed that you were overdue for your next screen. For women 75 and older, the benefits of continuing to screen depend on your personal health (how healthy you are overall).

### What do I need to do?

- ❖ Speak with your healthcare provider about whether or not continuing to screen is right for you.

If you decide to continue breast cancer screening, you won't receive reminder letters or MALs from the ABCSP. This is because the ABCSP won't know your personal health needs.
