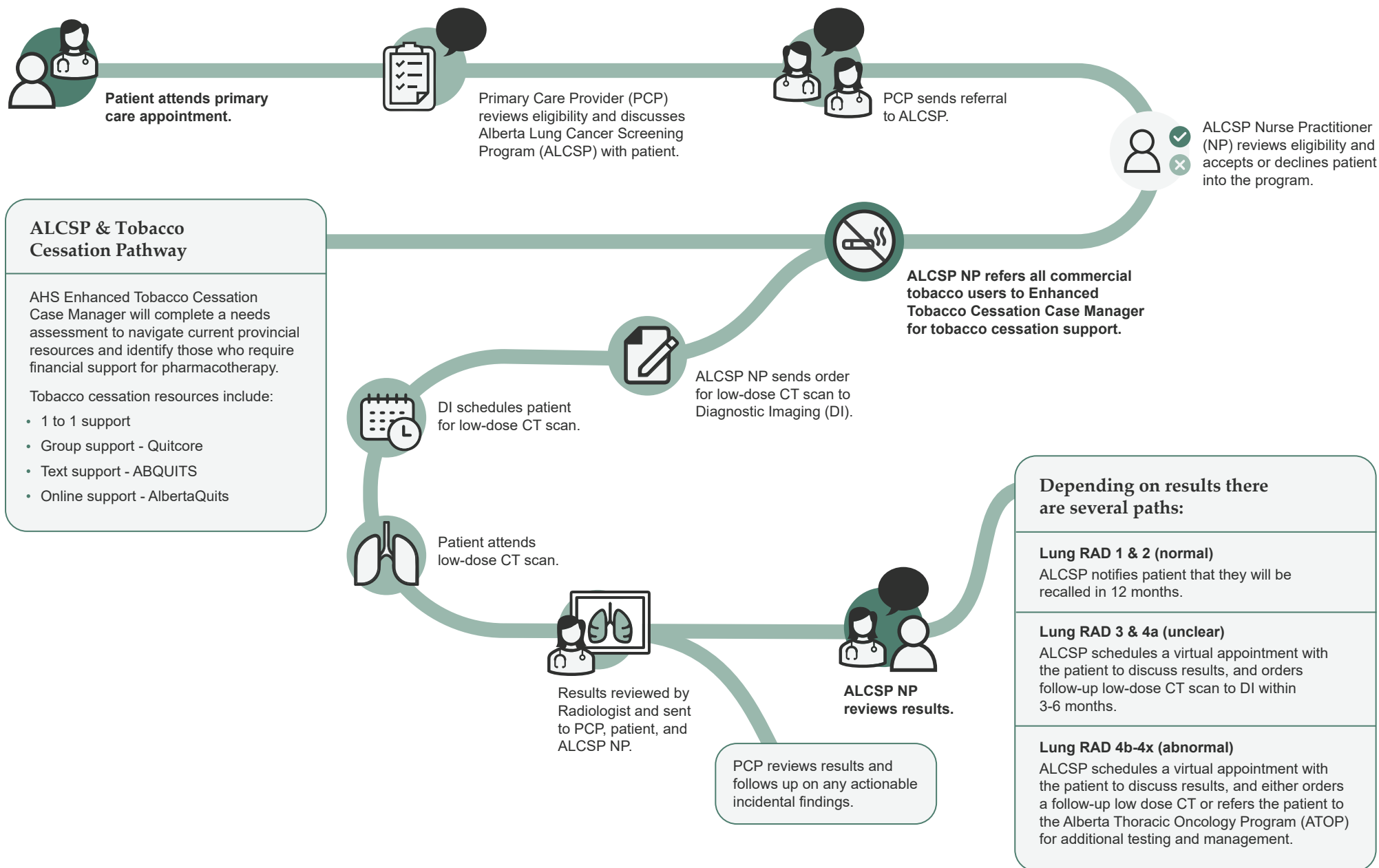


# Patient Pathway

### ALCSP & Tobacco Cessation Pathway

AHS Enhanced Tobacco Cessation Case Manager will complete a needs assessment to navigate current provincial resources and identify those who require financial support for pharmacotherapy.

Tobacco cessation resources include:

- 1 to 1 support
- Group support - Quitcore
- Text support - ABQUITS
- Online support - AlbertaQuits

### Depending on results there are several paths:

**Lung RAD 1 & 2 (normal)**  
ALCSP notifies patient that they will be recalled in 12 months.

**Lung RAD 3 & 4a (unclear)**  
ALCSP schedules a virtual appointment with the patient to discuss results, and orders follow-up low-dose CT scan to DI within 3-6 months.

**Lung RAD 4b-4x (abnormal)**  
ALCSP schedules a virtual appointment with the patient to discuss results, and either orders a follow-up low dose CT or refers the patient to the Alberta Thoracic Oncology Program (ATOP) for additional testing and management.
